

Penis. Pouch of skin that the testicles hang in below the

penis.

Testicles. Tube that carries the semen through the penis and

outside of the body during ejaculation. The urine also passes through this tube, but never at the

same time as the semen.

Scrotum. Hang in the scrotum and produce hormones

including testosterone and produce the male

reproductive cell called sperm.

Urethra. The male sexual organ. Can be flaccid (soft, floppy)

or erect (hard, straight).
